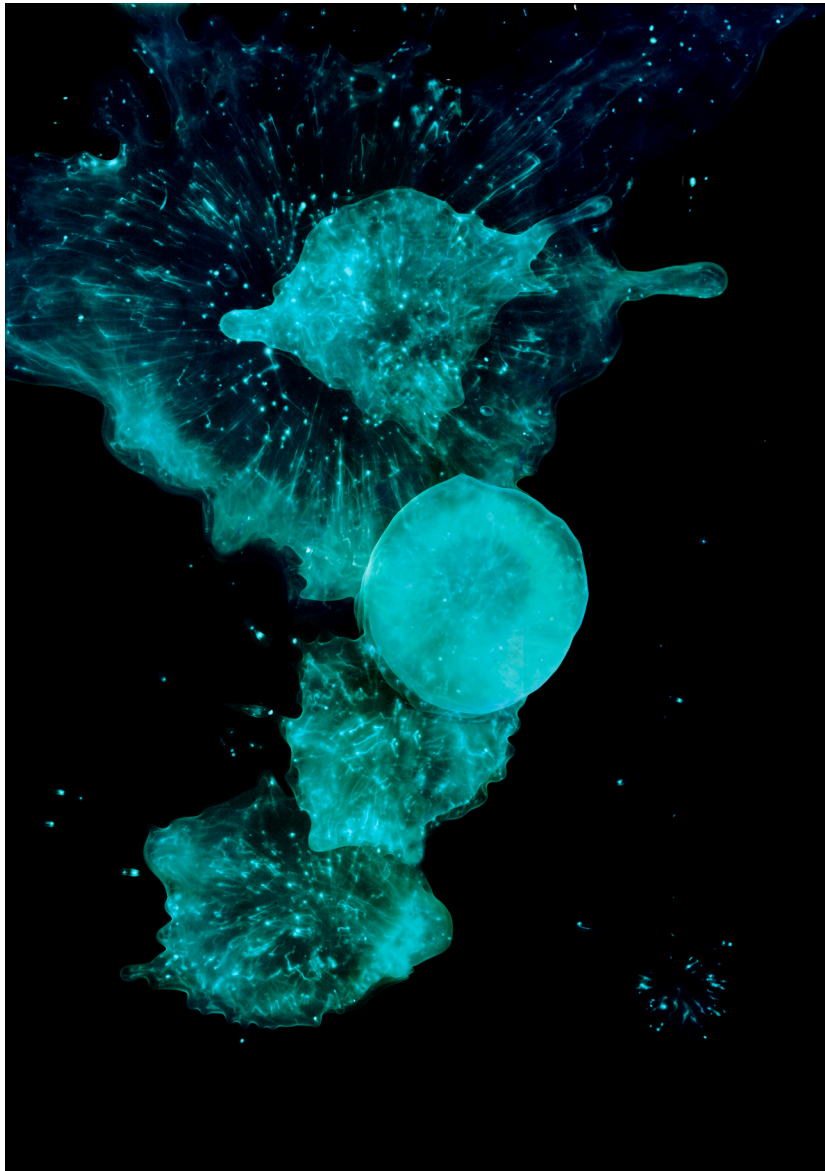
The Gallery also offers a program of cultural events and thematic workshops aimed at increasing different techniques and artistic expressions.

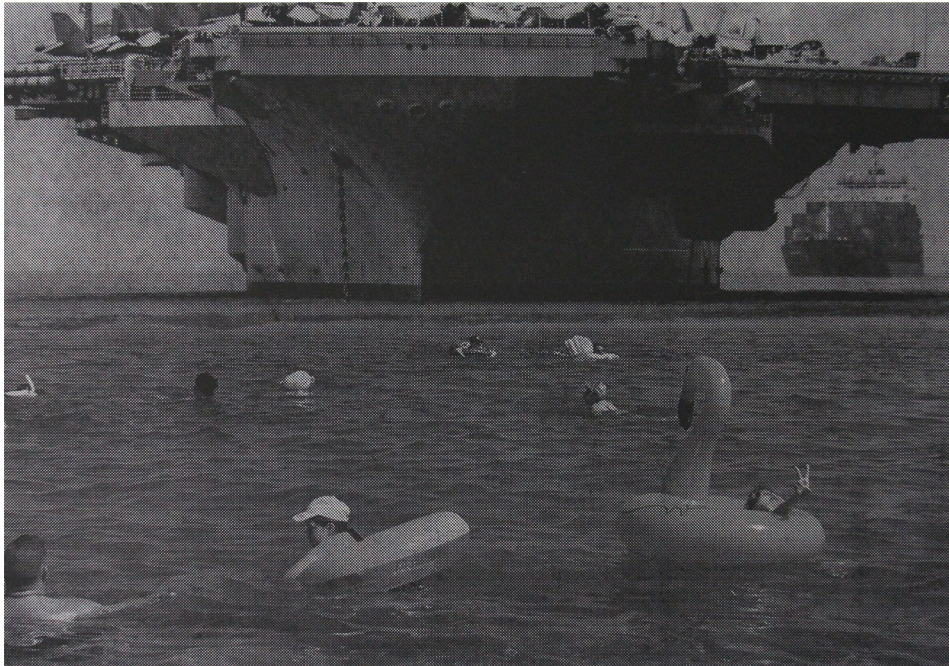
